The PCAL committee recently met and would like to pass on some policies for 2024 PCAL going forward. Please read and share with teammates.

- <u>Duties and Coverage</u> Duties will be listed on the Google sheet of each PCAL schedule. That sheet will be emailed and posted on the PCAL private Facebook group. If you have arranged for someone to cover duties for you communicate with an email to PCAL@usarenapolo.com who will be covering your duty. This will allow PCAL management to change the name on the duty. The person listed on the schedule sheet will be the person responsible for covering the duty. Duty no-shows and late arrivals will be charged \$100.
- <u>Yellow Cards</u> PCAL is a competitive league and we value camaraderie, sportsmanship and safety highly. Any player receiving a yellow card will not be eligible for individual awards (MVP, Sportsmanship, BPP) for the game they receive a yellow card in.
- Player Representative Every PCAL has a medic at the games and that medic is responsible for possible injuries during games. All players *need* to have a representative that can help if further treatment at a medical facility is needed in case of injury or illness. Minors **MUST** have a representative onsite, with permission to treat, to handle any health or injury situation that may arise. Please make sure your home club manager and PCAL manager are aware of who the minor's designated representative is before each event if a parent is not in attendance.
- <u>Substitution</u> The committee wishes to clarify polo substitution protocol. Unless prior arrangements have been made, the player needing the substitute mounts the substitute and covers costs (entry fee, horse rental).
